Discontinuation of course

The course *Swedish for International Students 1: Oral Proficiency and Listening Comprehension G1N, 7.5 credits (SV126G)* is being phased out and will no longer be offered at the University of Skövde. The course was given for the last time in the spring of 2018.

The course consists of three examination parts: Written examination 2.5 credits, Oral examination 3.5 credits and Listening comprehension 1.5 credits.

The following examinations are offered to students who have not completed the course:

Written examination 2.5 credits

The dates and times when the exams take place have not been determined yet. The exam, however, will take place one day during each period:

14 March 2022–3 April 2022 Registration no later than 15 February 2022
