Discontinuation of a course

The course English: Writing Texts about Facts and Opinions G1N, 7.5 credits (EN252G) is being phased out and will no longer be offered at the University of Skövde. The course was given for the last time in the spring of 2023.

The course consists of four examination parts: Individual assignment: Narrative text 2 credits, Individual assignment: Analytical text 2 credits, Individual assignment: Argumentative text 2 credits and Grammar quiz 1.5 credits.
